Re: Director's Report

Glacial Valley Playground Update

After numerous discussions with the community and feedback from the committee and vendors, we've decided to work exclusively with Boland Recreation, Inc., a distributor for Miracle Recreation, for the Glacial Valley Playground Update. Miracle Recreation offers "Sourcewell Pricing", which is a cooperative government sourcing program that assists public agencies with costs of their playground purchases by pooling all of its members' together. By doing so, we'll gain access to numerous suppliers of trusted brands and have a more direct contact with the supplier on design and construction.

Current proposed equipment to include in our design include:

- Encompass structures for 2-5 and 5-12
- Dinosaur Theme (If Possible)
- Minimum two Mega-towers with bridge connection
- Three-Four (3-4) slides
- Netting/webbing connections
- Generation Swing
- Gravity Rail
- 2 Color Pallet Options
 - (Sky, Orange, Light Gray)
 - Sky, Chartreuse, Light Gray)

Staff will continue to work with Boland Recreation with options to include and/or change for our site plan. Once 2-3 concept plans are in place, we'll provide them to the PRC and Community to vote on. Boland has been given Monday, February 17, 2020 as a date to propose the three concept plans.

Department and Staff Goals and Objectives

Staff have been working on goals, objectives and policies for the 2020. The department has regularly used the SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Results-Focused, Time-Bound) model to create this outline for both departmental and professional growth. This process has become an integral part in outlining both department and personal growth, focusing on current and future growth and development in our community. Staff will provide these goals to you in February 2020.

Ice Rink – Municipal Park

The Village of Cross Plains ice rink, located in the parking lot of the Cross Plains Pool is currently open for the season and has received a lot of use. Staff have been working to keep it open, including removing snow and resurfacing when needed. Staff has seen an increase in use which is always great to see.

Youth Basketball

Youth basketball begins in the month of January with 89 participants, ages 2nd grade-8th grade. Participants practice one day per week with games on Saturdays. The program stresses *FUN*damentals and team work, providing each child with equal playing time. A tournament is provided for 4th-8th grade on February 29 in numerous locations, including Cross Plains, Monona, Stoughton, Verona, Middleton, Stoughton and Waunakee.

Cross Plains Parks and Recreation Department – After School Program

The After-School Program currently has 38 participants for the month of January. Staff has received a number of compliments from parents and participants of the program. I'd like to recognize employees Katarena Ketelboeter and Andrea Fullerton for their development and implementation of this program. They've both been a tremendous asset to our community, listening to the needs and responding with a creative and positive opportunity. They've both done a fantastic job creating policy, communicating with parents and staff, and keeping a positive attitude. Thank you for all you do!

2020 Spring-Summer Activity Guide

Staff is currently working on the 2020 activity guide, including new opportunities for all ages! As directed, staff's working to get the information out to the community by February 21, 2020. This will be roughly one month earlier than years previous. To do so, staff decided that we needed to control the design and layout, no longer working with private services. By doing so, we've been able to save roughly \$1400 while also keeping more control of the process.

PRIORITIES

Setting priorities for the Glacial Valley Park Playground update will have a direct impact on the design and final product. Core factors to keep in mind when setting such priorities include: Budget, Dimensions/Space, Age Range.

Budget: Money approved for this project: \$125,000.00.

Needs: What ages and abilities will use the area? 2-5 and 5-12

Space: The current site plan is roughly 6900 sq ft. (Current Footprint)

Community Priorities to take into account in no particular order:

Dinosaur Theme

Mega-deck structure (2) with bridge connection

Large and small slides (Minimum 2)

Gravity Rail/Zip Line

Face to Face Swing

Nets and ropes (Climber) – Could also serve as “obstacle course”.

Concrete/asphalt path to equipment and other amenities.

Shade

I've prepared a staff budget estimate for your viewing to help put together and visualize the overall project. This form can serve the committee as a foundation for setting priorities on the project. I've labeled 2 options and hope we're all able to use this document to provide a final Request for Proposals.

2. Discussion and possible action regarding Village owned property East of Baer Park. –

There has been a request for the Parks, Recreation and Conservancy Committee to establish green space for the addition of a playground on property East of Baer Park. (Picture Below) The calculation of land that was to be dedicated to the Village of Cross Plains for park purposes is 1.4 acres. (Blue Space)

Staff is currently working with Vandewalle and Associates on a master plan for the roughly 16 acres of Village owned land. Staff would like to continue working with Vandewalle and introduce the space in blue as “phase 1”, locating a playground to the site. Once approved, staff would like to have a visioning session with Glacier Ridge Neighborhood to discuss amenities to include in their 1.4 acre park design.



3. Discussion and possible action regarding 2020 Parks, Recreation and Conservancy Committee goals and objectives.

– Staff would like for the committee to discuss goals and set objectives for 2020, pertaining to Parks, Recreation, Conservancy and Aquatics. Discussion on these goals and objectives shall take place over the next couple of months, giving everyone a clear indication of their responsibilities.

1. ***Discussion and possible action regarding the use of ATV/UTV's on public streets within the Village of Cross Plains boundaries.*** The Village of Cross Plains Public Safety Committee unanimously approved the request to open Village streets as road routes for ATV/UTV's within the Village boundaries and has been sent to the Village board for consideration. At this time, Doug Brunner- Cross Plains Area Wheelers, is requesting the same approval from the Parks, Recreation and Conservancy Committee. An update from Doug Brunner is included in this packet. At this time, staff doesn't have any concerns with the proposal providing no such use is extended into any Village owned parks or conservancies. Staff would recommend a Motor Vehicle Use Agreement be formulated for ANY/ALL uses in Village owned parking lots. ***FOR APPROVAL***

2. ***Presentation and discussion of the survey results of the H.M. Zander Community Nature Park Visioning Session.*** The Village held a public Visioning Session on Wednesday, November 20, 2019. The purpose of the Visioning Session was to, identify the scale, events and opportunities associated with adding a structure in H.M. Zander Community Nature Park, as outlined in the 2019-2024 Parks and Open Space Plan, as the top recommendation for improvement to existing parks. Results for such include:
 - Size
 - 30'X40'
 - Design
 - Arched roof
 - Stone Columns
 - Simple and Contemporary (Plover)
 - Storage
 - Events
 - Music/Concerts in the Park
 - Craft Fair/Art
 - Food Carts

The Village distributed a communitywide survey online (surveymonkey) November 21-December 20, 2019. Questions were directly in line with the questions from the Visioning Session. The Village received 40 responses, which indicated a high level of support for a multipurpose structure to host live outdoor music. The Parks and Open Space Plan also indicated that residents wanted to see more placemaking improvements, like an outdoor performance venue and place to host public art. The detailed survey is included in the packet.

3. Discussion and possible action regarding a Request for Proposals for a Parks Plan, including preliminary engineering and design work for an amphitheater in H.M. Zander Community Nature Park. Staff has worked to draft a Request for Proposals to solicit proposals to hire a qualified firm or consultant(s) to provide conceptual design services to help properly plan for the construction of a 30'X40' Polygon Constellation Amphitheater, or similar, open air structure to be added in H.M. Zander Community Nature Park. No funding was secured in the 2020 budget for this project. As staff continues to work to keep this project in motion, related support services are needed. Staff would request approval for this project with the funding source to be determined by the Village Board. *FOR APPROVAL*

Scope of services will include:

- Phase 1
 - Conceptual site plan and related material to gain support for the project within the community.
 - Detailed Cost Estimate for the project.
 - Identify and define any encroachments, permits and/or regulatory approval required to be resolved in phase 2.
 - All aspects of design will comply with the American with Disabilities Act and State building regulations.
 - Attendance at up to 2 public meetings.
- Phase 2
 - Final Design and Bidding
- Phase 3
 - Construction

Parks and Rec Committee Updates:

Progress on Road Routes & Trails in and around the Village of Cross Plains.

- Presented at the Town of Berry and Town of Cross Plains and Town of Vermont. All look promising and are gathering information and establishing process for implementation.
- Private trail options look good both South and North. We have landowner's permission and are defining the specific routes.
- Village Safety Committee unanimously approved for consideration to the Village of CP Board.

Parks and Rec Specific Notes:

- The request is to use village road routes only. There will be no access in any village parks or conservancy.
- We would like specific permission from the committee to continue to plow Raspberry park parking lot and basketball court. This will be a pilot with the hope of adding a couple more secondary lots to our volunteers.
- We would like the committee to support the addition of ATV-UTV road routes within the village and allow the Village Board and Public Safety Committee to address specific safety concerns. It's another great Recreational opportunity for our residents

Cross Plains Area Wheelers Updates:

- Voted to merge with the Badger ATV Club of Mount Horeb, WI effective 1-1-2020.
- This merger will strengthen numbers to approximately 150 members and 50 business sponsors.
- This action will also establish a Safety & Road Routes committee for the ongoing administration of new and existing road routes and trails. Committee will have 3 teams (Safety & Training, Road Routes & Trails)
- We are excited about this update and consider it a win-win for all involved.



Jackson County Trails Study – UW River Falls – James Jenke & David Trechter

Non-local respondents reported spending between \$355 and \$427 on average in Jackson County. The largest expenditures were for lodging and food and drink. Total expenditures at Jackson County businesses by non-county trail users are estimated to be between \$7.6 million and \$9.2 million annually. Some of these expenditures remain in the Jackson County economy as businesses make purchases from other local businesses and employees and owners spend their wages and profits on local purchases.

To measure overall economic impact of trail visitors on the Jackson County economy, we need to account for the direct, indirect, and induced effects of non-county trail users. Direct impacts focus on the spending by non-county trail users. Indirect economic impacts are business-to-business transactions generated by trail users. For example, increased purchases of meals by visiting trail users would cause a restaurant to increase purchases of various foods for their menus. Induced impacts are the additional economic activity generated by the way workers and owners spend the incomes they earned from trail-related expenditures. For instance a worker in restaurant frequented by non-county trail users will spend some of his/her wages and tips on rent, and the landlord, in turn will spend some of this rent money at the local grocery store. The total (direct + indirect + induced) impact measures the net increase in economic activity (labor income plus profits) generated by non-locals who use Jackson County trails. The estimated annual economic impact of expenditures by non-county trail users are as follows:

- Between 118 and 142 jobs created/sustained
- Between \$2.0 million and \$2.4 million in labor income
- Between \$4.0 million and \$4.6 million added to the Jackson County economy.
- Between \$7.8 million and \$9.34 million of total economic activity (mostly labor income and profits)

Tri County Trails Study – University of Wisconsin

During the 12 month study period, the Cheese Country Trail experienced roughly 98,000 visitor days of use (one day's use of the trail by an individual trail user). Two-thirds of all visitor days were by trail users not from the local three county region. Almost $\frac{3}{4}$ of all visitor days occurred on weekends or holidays. The majority of Cheese Country Trail usage occurred between Memorial Day and Labor Day. A surprisingly high level of use occurred during the month of October. A modest amount of snowmobile usage occurred during the winter of 2010/2011 but was hampered by lack of snow and trail closures. **The Cheese Country Trail attracts an older crowd of outdoor recreationists; average age of user was in the mid-40's with non-local trail users tending to be older than local trail users. Non-local trail users were more apt to be college educated and had significantly higher household incomes when compared to local Cheese Country Trail users.** The Cheese Country Trail was the primary reason why most non-local visitors were in Green, Lafayette, and/or Iowa Counties. The highest concentration of Cheese Country Trail access occurred in either Monroe or Darlington. Day-trips accounted for nearly $\frac{3}{4}$ of all Cheese Country Trail usage. Non-locals often spent overnights in the area in local campgrounds or hotels and motels. Trail users also participated in related activities such as dining and shopping during their trips. Overall, trail users were generally satisfied with the important attributes of the trail itself. Individual trip expenditure patterns were very different when comparing local trail users with non-local trail users. **On average, individual non-local trail users spent between \$175 and \$220 per trip, depending on the time of year.**

Total spending of trail users exceeded \$15 million during the 12 month study period. Non-local trail user spending provided an economic stimulus that infused over \$13 million into the local economy during the 12 month study period. Non-local trail user spending supported almost 190 local jobs and contributed to almost \$3 million in employee compensation for local residents of Green, Lafayette, and Iowa Counties. A host of public policy issues need to be addressed in order to maintain and enhance local development efforts relating to the Cheese Country Trail.
