BURNING PERMIT

It is the intent of chapter 33.01 to prescribe regulations consistent with nationally recognized standards for the safeguarding to a reasonable degree of life and property from hazard of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling, and use of hazardous substances, materials, and devices and from conditions of hazardous to life, property and the environment in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises. Compliance with codes and standards of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), State of Wisconsin, or other approved nationally recognized safety standards, as later referred to or as specified in this code, shall be deemed to be prima facie evidence of compliance with this intent.

General Limitations	
<p><i>Open burning is prohibited without first obtaining a Burning Permit. Strictly burning rubbish, leaves, construction waste, and other similar material as a means of disposal is prohibited. Burning Permits may be issued by the Administrator/Clerk subject to notification of the Fire Chief according to the following conditions: Please initial next to each duty to signify agreement.</i></p>	
1. Applicant provides their name, address, address where the burning is to be conducted (if different), phone number, date of scheduled burn, approximate time of burn, rainout date of burn, and material to be burned. (Location should be marked with an "x" on attached map.)	
2. Burning may only be conducted when wind is calm.	
3. Burning shall be controlled and completed safely.	
4. Fire shall be monitored by applicant at all time.	
5. Burning shall be done at a time and conditions as to cause the least inconvenience to the people in the area.	
6. No burning may be conducted in curbs and/or in the street.	
7. No burning is allowed at any time during drought conditions subject to the discretion of the Fire Chief and Village.	
8. A fee may be established by resolution of the Village Board. (\$10.00)	
Additional Limitations:	
1. Applicant must notify the Fire Chief by email (chief@crossplainsfire.com) within 24-hours of anticipated burn date/time.
