I. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Roll Call

President Andreoni called the regular Plan Commission meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Present: Commissioners Doug Brunner, Todd Duquette, Mitch Hogan, Randy Case, Ron Hilmanowski, Judy Ketelboeter and President Pat Andreoni.

II. Public Comment – None.

III. General Business

1. Discussion and action regarding the minutes of the regular meeting held August 4, 2014 – A motion was made by Commissioner Duquette, seconded by Commissioner Brunner, and unanimously carried by the Plan Commission to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held August 4, 2014.

2. Consideration of an Ordinance to repeal current Zoning (Chapter 4) and enact new Zoning (Chapter 84) -

a. Public Hearing

- A motion was made by Commissioner Duquette, seconded by Commissioner Brunner, for the Plan Commission to open the Public Hearing at 7:04 pm. A roll call vote was requested. Yes – Andreoni, Brunner, Duquette, Case, Ketelboeters, Hilmanowski and Hogan. Motion carried 7-0.
- Mike Slavney reviewed the changes since the last meeting to the zoning code being considered.
- A motion was made by Commissioner Brunner, seconded by Commissioner Hogan, and unanimously carried by the Plan Commission to close the Public Hearing at 7:34 pm.

b. Discussion and action to make a recommendation to the Village Board – A motion was made by Commissioner Brunner, seconded by Commissioner Duquette, and unanimously carried by the Plan Commission to recommend approval to the Village Board approval of an ordinance to repeal current Zoning (Chapter 4) and enact new Zoning (Chapter 84), and that the Village Administrator provide a progress report on issues with the new code in a year.

A motion was made by Commissioner Brunner, seconded by Commissioner Case, and unanimously carried by the Plan Commission to adjourn the meeting at 7:51 pm.
