 - ii. Brought up 3 possible areas

1. Brewery Creekside Park – group discussed that this is very narrow and not a great location for a dog park.
2. Conservancy trail south of Hillebrand
3. Raspberry Park
4. Buechner area?

Questions were will this be a dog park specific, or mixed use.

There should be 1 park where dogs should be allowed and leashes optional.

Water in not necessary but a “nice to have” a lot of parks are dry

Incidence of dogs not on lease in parks or conservancy area aggressive to people and other dogs

Law enforcement not doing anything about enforcing park rules, police have told citizens that dogs are allowed off leash in the park.

Puppy area?
