CHAPTER 8 CONTRACTS AND BIDDING

SECTION 8.01 Contracts for Public Construction.

Section 62.15, Wis. Stats., is hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the process for the letting of Village contracts. All contracts for public construction not referred to in the above section of the Wisconsin Statutes adopted and incorporated by reference shall be let as the Village Board may direct. The Village Board may also, by a vote of $\frac{3}{4}$ of the members-elect, provide that any class of public construction or any part thereof may be done directly by the Village without submitting the same for bids.

SECTION 8.02 Exceptions for Public Emergencies.

The provisions of Section 8.01 of this chapter and of Section 281.41, Wis. Stats., are not mandatory for the repair and reconstruction of public facilities when damage or threatened damage thereto creates an emergency, in which the public health or welfare of the Village is endangered, as determined by resolution of the Village Board. Whenever the Village Board determines by majority vote at a regular or special meeting that such emergency no longer exists, this section no longer applies.

SECTION 8.03 Work Done by Village.

Whenever the Village Board shall have provided that any class of public work or any part thereof may be done directly by the Village without submitting the same for bids as provided in Section 8.01 and any such public work shall be done in accordance with such ordinance, the Village Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer, or his designee, shall keep an accurate account of the cost thereof, including the necessary overhead expense. Upon the completion of such work the Village Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer, or his designee, shall make a complete report thereof to the Village Board, stating in detail the items of cost and the total cost of doing such work, and the Village Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer shall publish such report as part of the proceedings of the Village Board.
