

Cross Plains Child Passenger Safety Program Free Car Seat Check & Recycling Event

The Cross Plains Child Passenger Safety Program will provide free car seat inspections and education on Saturday, May 3rd, from 8:30 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. at the Cross Plains Fire Department, 1501 Bourbon Road, Cross Plains, WI. This event will include car seat inspections by Nationally Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians. Technicians will be on hand to teach parents and caregivers how to choose the right car seats for their children, how to install them correctly, and how to ensure the car seats are being used correctly.

The Cross Plains Child Passenger Safety Program is dedicated to helping parents and caregivers make sure their children ride as safely as possible every time they are in vehicles. Our Nationally Certified Child Passenger Safety technicians will teach families how to correctly secure their child and give families the information they need to correct any mistakes when using car seats, booster seats and seat belts. The Cross Plains CPS Program also has car seats available for families who may not be able to otherwise afford a proper child car seat.

The Cross Plains CPS Program has also arranged to recycle any used, damaged, or expired car seats. The use of used, damaged, or expired seats is discouraged as these seats can compromise the safety of your children. These types of car seats may not hold up in a crash and may subject your children to increased and unnecessary injuries or death. Don't risk a child's safety by using these seats – take this opportunity to drop them off at the seat check event and have them properly recycled.

Don't miss out on this opportunity to have your child car seats checked.
