General Business

- 1. Discussion and action to set an open house meeting date to gather community input on the Glacial Valley Park playground and other amenity project.** – The Glacial Valley Park Playground was in the 2019 Capital Improvement Plan, approving \$100,000 for new playground, signage and other amenities. At this time, I'm hoping to secure a date in August to host an open meeting for the community to help generate possible elements to include in our Request for Proposals for area playground vendors. I'd also like to discuss the timeline for this project and alternative solutions.
- 2. Discussion to create a policy regarding resident versus non-resident sign up.** - During 2019, the department has experienced a number of concerns from local residents regarding the demand for recreation programs, most notably programs filling up before residents get a chance to sign up. I'd like to discuss possible solutions and create a policy to provide Village Residents a better opportunity to sign up for needed programming.
