Shall the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District, Dane County, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$138,900,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements of a school building and improvement program consisting of construction and equipping of a new elementary school; construction and equipping of an addition to the high school and related remodeling, demolition of a portion of the existing high school facility and reconstruction of the facility; construction and equipping of a cafeteria addition to Park Elementary School; and remodeling of the current Clark Street Community School for use as an early learning site for the District?
